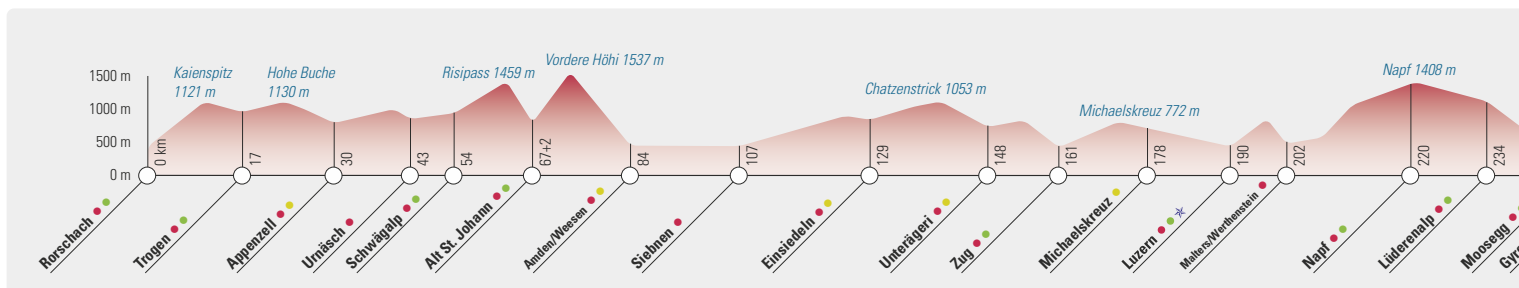

**CHARACTER**

The Alpine Panorama route passes through some Switzerland's most attractive areas at the foothills of the Alps on its way from Lake Constance to Lake Geneva: Appenzell, Toggenburg, Zugerland, Lucerne, Napfgebiet, Emmental, Greyerzerland, Lavaux and Côte d'Or are all home to milk and cheese, folklore, cherry pie, gold panning and a winegrowing culture.

**ELEVATION PROFILE AND ROUTE STAGES**



**PART 1: APPENZEL****RORSCHACH - HEIDEN - TROGEN**

Hiking time: 6:00

The panorama route runs from Lake Constance to Trogen – with the imposing rock massif of Mt. Säntis in front of you.

**TROGEN - APPENZEL**

Hiking time: 4:15

The Pestalozzi International Children's Village has carried the name of Trogen out into the world. Walking along pleasant elevated hiking tracks, the route takes you to the canton's capital town of Appenzel.

**APPENZEL - URNÄSCH**

Hiking time: 3:45

On the way to Gonten and Jakobsbad you can safely take your boots off and experience the soothing feeling of walking barefoot on the soft meadowland paths.

**URNÄSCH - SCHWÄGALP**

Hiking time: 3:55. Today the route mostly follows the waters of the Urnäsch. From the destination point of Schwägälp (1352m), you can take a cable car up the Säntis (2502m) for some magnificent views.

**SCHWÄGALP - STEIN - ALT ST. JOHANN**

Hiking time: 5:15. Whether the local place named «Dreckloch» (muddy hole) and «Dunkelboden» (dark ground) reflect the landscape is up to you to decide!

**ALT ST. JOHANN - AMDEN / WEESEN**

Hiking time: 6:20. A beautiful panoramic stretch which reaches the highest point of the day at Vorder Höhi (1537m). From Amden, descend down to Weesen.

**PART 2: CENTRAL SWITZERLAND****AMDEN / WEESEN - SIEBNEN**

Hiking time: 6:50. Three cantons, two lakes and a large valley – the Linthebene – are the ingredients for this flat walk from East to central Switzerland.

**SIEBNEN - EINSIEDELN**

Hiking time: 7:10

The route leads past the St. Meinrads chapel and birthplace of Paracelsus to the famous monastery village of Einsiedeln.

**EINSIEDELN - UNTERÄGERI**

Hiking time: 5:50

The Rothenturm mountain moorland is a protected area and one of the most beautiful and significant moorland areas in Europe.

**UNTERÄGERI - ZUG**

Hiking time: 3:35

After descending down from the Zugerberg, why not enjoy a slice of traditional cherry pie in the charming old town of Zug.

**ZUG - LUCERNE**

Hiking time: 8:00

This stage offers plenty of views of the lakes and mountains. Couples come from far and wide to marry at the Michaelskreuz chapel.

**Swiss Trails Tip:** This leg – as well as almost all other legs – can be shortened by bus.

**PART 3: EMMENTAL****LUCERNE - MALTERS / WERTHENSTEIN**

Hiking time: 5:50

Once you have crossed the forested Sonnenberg, it's time to enter the pure wilderness of Rengloch.

**WERTHENSTEIN - NAPP**

Hiking time: 7:50

The Baroque church in Werthenstein is well worth a visit. In Menzberg, you can enjoy the beautiful views of the Napfgebiet and Bernese Alps.

**NAPP - LÜDERNALP**

Hiking time: 4:15

This fantastic ridge walk from Napf to Lüderalp requires care and a steady foot.

**LÜDERNALP - MOOSEGG**

Hiking time: 5:15

This gentle mountain ridge walk takes you

towards through woodlands and meadows to the Greater Emme valley.

**MOOSEGG - MÜNSINGEN**

Hiking time: 5:00

The villages become larger and the hills smaller until they disappear completely in the Aare valley.

**MÜNSINGEN - RÜEGGISBERG**

Hiking time: 6:05

Panoramic Alpine views can be enjoyed again on the Belpberg mountain.

**RÜEGGISBERG - GUGGISBERG**

Hiking time: 5:40

The legendary Guggershörnli peak can be seen from far and wide.

**PART 4: GREYERZERLAND****GUGGISBERG - SCHWARZSEE**

Hiking time: 5:05

In Switzerland, the Guggisberg has an almost legendary reputation due to a popular folksong named «S Vreneli ab em Guggisberg» (Little Verena from Guggisberg).

**SCHWARZSEE - CHARMEY**

Hiking time: 6:50

The Schwarzsee lake is a jewel of the Greyerzerland area. The route leads through the unique natural landscapes of the Breccaschlund gorge.

**CHARMEY - GRUYÈRES**

Hiking time: 3:20

The medieval village of Gruyères welcomes visitors from afar. It is one of the most visited sites in Switzerland.

**GRUYÈRES - LES PACCOTS**

Hiking time: 5:40

The characteristic Moléson can be reached by mountain railway or by climbing – the Alpine Panorama trail recommends the intermediate station of Plan Francey.

**LES PACCOTS - VEVEY**

Hiking time: 6:15

Les Pléiades is reached via lush pastures and scented forests.

**Swiss Trails Tip:** The descent to Blonay and Vevey is easiest by rack railway.

**VEVEY - LAUSANNE**

Hiking time: 5:00

The climate in Lavaux (a world heritage site since 2007) is milder than anywhere else in Switzerland. The wines produced here have made the name famous worldwide.

**PART 5: LAKE GENEVA****LAUSANNE - MORGES**

Hiking time: 3:05

Time to enjoy a drink at a lake-side café or take a refreshing dip in the lake.

**MORGES - AUBONNE**

Hiking time: 5:10

Walk to the mediaeval town of Aubonne along the banks of the lake, through fields and meadows and past castles and villas.

**AUBONNE - COINSINS**

Hiking time: 6:35

A morning of beautiful views through the vineyards and wine-growing villages – and an afternoon of shade walking along the Serine stream.

**COINSINS - CHAVANNES-DE-BOGIS**

Hiking time: 3:15

The backland areas between Lake Geneva and Jura with their dreamy villages, old castles, babbling brooks and bright oak forests.

**CHAVANNES-DE-BOGIS - GENEVA**

Hiking time: 6:35

Pure nature along the mountain streams of Versoix and a well-deserved break on the outskirts of Geneva!
