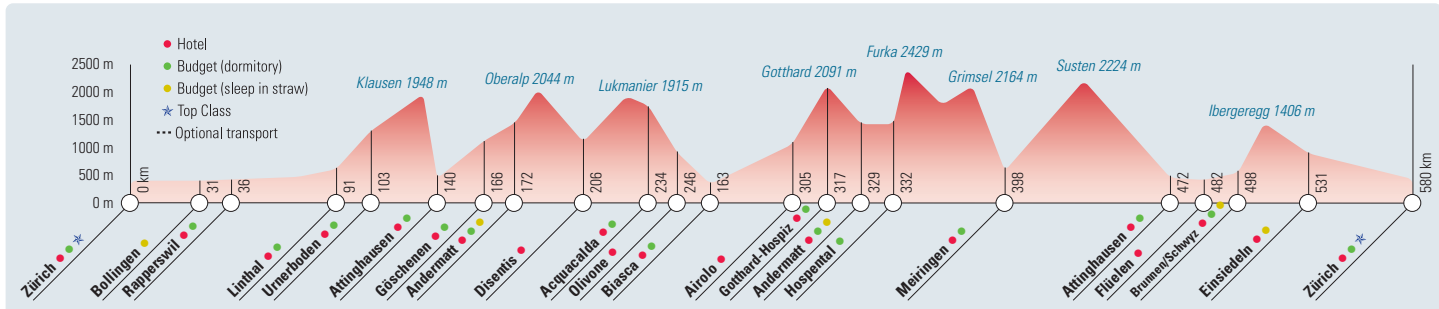

ELEVATION PROFILE AND ROUTE



CHARACTER

The Land of Cycling consists of 9 national and numerous regional routes. SwissTrails has brought together some of the most attractive routes through the Alps to form a spectacular round trip for racing bikes which is unique in Europe: the asphalted and signposted route comprises eight Alpine passes.

ROUTE**ZÜRICH - LINTHAL 91 km**

The flat stretch along Lake Zürich to Rapperswil and through the Linthebene region to Glarus is an ideal stage for warming up and easing yourself in gently.

LINTHAL - KLAUSENPASS**- ANDERMATT 81 km**

Covering 1948m, the Klausenpass is the first picturesque challenge. The descent through the Schächental to Altdorf is surrounded by

waterfalls. The climb up to Göschenen and Andermatt leads through the Schöllenen-schlucht gorge with its Teufelsbrücke.

ANDERMATT - OBERALPPASS**- DISENTIS - LUKMANIERPASS****- BIASCA 101 km (only option A)**

The Oberalppass (2044m) leads to the pretty monastery town of Disentis (1142m); here, turn right over the Lukmanierpass (1915m) to Tessin, on to Olivone and through the picturesque Bleniotal valley to Biasca (303m).

BIASCA - GOTTHARDPASS**- ANDERMATT 64 km (only option A)**

The route leads through the Leventina district, up to Airolo (1141m) and through the legendary Tremolaschlucht gorge with its hairpin bends to the Gotthardpass (2106m). Andermatt (1447m) then lies just ahead.

ANDERMATT - FURKAPASS**- GRIMSELPASS - MEIRINGEN 69 km**

This is the main stage and reaches the highest point of the tour on the Furka (2429m).

From Gletsch (1757m), the short climb continues on to the Grimselpass (2164m) and the descent through the Haslital valley to Meiringen.

MEIRINGEN - SUSTENPASS**- BRUNNEN 96 km**

The Sustenpass, is one of the most attractive Alpine pass routes – here, cyclists can breathe in the high mountain air! The route then runs down through the Reusstal valley and along the Axenstrasse road to Lake Lucerne and the destination of Brunnen.

BRUNNEN - IBERGEREGG - ZÜRICH**65 km**

The Ibergereg (1406m) may seem like a challenge too far – but the journey along the Sihlsee Lake and on to the monastery village of Einsiedeln is particularly beautiful. Lake Zurich runs alongside the last section of this Alpine Pass Tour.
